**Entry fee:** \$20.00 (includes one year subscription)

AWCS Members \$10.00

Additional entries \$5.00 (at time of original only)

**Maximum** 3000 words prose, or 5 poems per entry.

Prose entries must be double spaced with a title and page number at the top of each page, NO authors name on entry.

Poetry entries must be single spaced, NO authors name on entry. Poems that run more than one page require a title and page number at the top of each page.

Entry page size, 8.5"x11" with a 1" margin all around, Times New Roman 12pt font..

An original paper copy of the entry must be received on or before **December 31st, 2007**. Entries must be accompanied by the completed entry form and fee. Cheque or money order payable to FreeFall. Visa and Mastercard accepted as well. An entry number will be generated and emailed to the author upon receipt of the entry. The author must then email an electronic copy of the entry with the entry number in the email subject field.
